Memorial Tree Maintenance

- Maintain mulch around trees. Do not pile mulch against the tree trunk. Use only natural mulch. Mulch should be 2 to 4 inches deep, no more. You may mulch out to the dripline of the tree.

- **2.** Keep vegetation very short or remove all vegetation within the mulch zone.
- **3.** Do not lean bricks, stones or other objects against the trunk.
- **4.** Do not leave any tags, wires or other material on trees
- **5.** Generously water trees every 7 to 10 days if an unusually dry period occurs during the growing season. Do not overwater trees.
- **6.** Prune dead or broken branches during the dormant season, preferably late winter
- **7.** Tree tubes, wraps or guards can be used to deter deer from rubbing trees. Be careful not to damage trees with any device put on the trunk.
